# Permanent Pet License Tags Enclosed



The enclosed tag serves as a permanent pet license tag for the life of your pet. This new tag is made of durable stainless steel and does not require annual replacement.

**A renewal notice will still be mailed to you each year, but when you renew, a new tag will not be sent -- simply retain the enclosed stainless steel tag.**

If your pet loses the tag, or it is destroyed, a new one can be obtained by contacting Regional Animal Services of King County and paying a small replacement fee, currently \$5. This simple change will save thousands of dollars each year in postage, making more resources available to shelter lost and homeless animals, and provides medical care for injured animals at the King County Pet Adoption Center.
